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Dr. Ravindra Mehta – USA

He holds a patent for “Continuous Hemodialysis Using Citrate”. He chairs the annual International AKI& CRRT Conference in San Diego that is now in its 25th year. He has more than 200 original research publications, 100 reviews and book chapters; a founding member of the Acute Dialysis Quality Initiative (ADQI) and the Acute Kidney Injury network (AKIN), a member of the KDIGO Guidelines in AKI committee and served as the director of the ISN 0 by 25 initiative to eliminate preventable deaths from AKI by 2025.



Javier A. Neyra, -US

He has implemented a specialized AKI Survivor Clinic that follows over 100 survivors of AKI per year. His research includes: risk-stratification, mechanisms of recovery, and progression to acute and chronic kidney disease. Has developed a multidisciplinary quality management system to establish and monitor metrics for continuous renal replacement therapy (CRRT) deliverables in the intensive care unit (ICU).



Dr. Marcus Broman -Sweden

Highly rated in top areas of expertise are Malignant Hyperthermia, Acute Kidney Failure, Toxic Shock Syndrome, and Hypophosphatemia. His clinical research consists of co-authoring 30 peer reviewed articles and participating in 2 clinical trials in the past 15 years. (Comparing Cytokines, Toxins Adsorbing oXiris Filter to ST150 Filter During CRRT in Patients With Septic Shock)



Dr Max Bell -Belgium

His research interests span from AKI-epidemiology, biomarkers of renal damage, via CRRT to perioperative outcomes. He has published book chapters and more than 70 peer reviewed papers in the field. Highly rated in Acute Kidney Failure, Low Blood Pressure, Pheochromocytoma, and Chronic Kidney Disease. His clinical research: co-authoring 96 peer reviewed articles and participating in 5 clinical trials in the past 15 years. (Early vs Late CRRT, a Propensity Matched Multicenter Cohort Study)



Dr. Michael Joannidis –Austria

Highly rated in Acute Kidney Failure, Sepsis, Toxic Shock Syndrome, and Syndrome of Inappropriate Antidiuretic Hormone Secretion. His clinical research: co-authoring 236 peer reviewed articles, 2 clinical trials in the past 15 years. Comparison of Biphosyl® and Phoxilium® as a Replacement Fluid During CVVH for AKI in Adults and Their Effects on pH-, Bicarbonate-levels and Respiratory Situation - A Prospective, Randomized, Controlled, Open, Cross-over, Phase II, Single-center Pilot Study [BiPhox-Trial]
